Households will be notified of their children's eligibility for free meals if they are members of households receiving assistance from the:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), if the State program meets Federal standards.

Households will be notified of any child's eligibility for free meals if the individual child is Other Source Categorically Eligible, because the child is categorized, as defined by law as:

- Homeless
- Migrant
- Runaway
- A foster child
- Enrolled in Head Start
- Enrolled in an eligible pre-kindergarten class.

If children or households receive benefits under Assistance Programs or Other Source Categorically Eligible Programs and are not listed on the notice of eligibility and are not notified by the school of their free meal benefits, the parent or guardian should contact the school or should submit an income application.

Households notified of their children's eligibility must contact the LEA or school if the household chooses to decline the free meal benefits.
