MCAS Summer Program

The MCAS Summer Program is designed to help those students who have failed or are in danger of failing MCAS. Students who qualify for this program will receive a letter of notification in the mail. For those students the program is free of charge because of a grant provided by the Massachusetts Department of Education. Courses can be taken in conjunction with summer school. The MCAS Summer Program can be taken for 2.5 or 5 credits.
